

Updating the E-Tuner App from the Play Store:

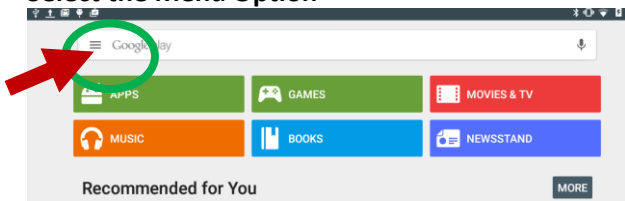
Before Proceeding, add a Google Account to your Android Device. You will need to be connected to the internet (WIFI/Data Plan) first.

For more info on connecting to the internet & setting up a Google Account, read: E-Tuner App – Preliminary Setup instructions.

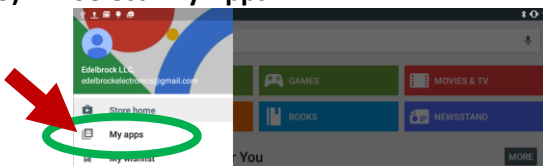
1) Open the Google Play Store App:



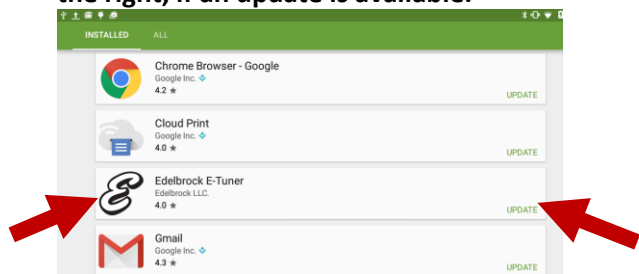
2) Select the Menu Option



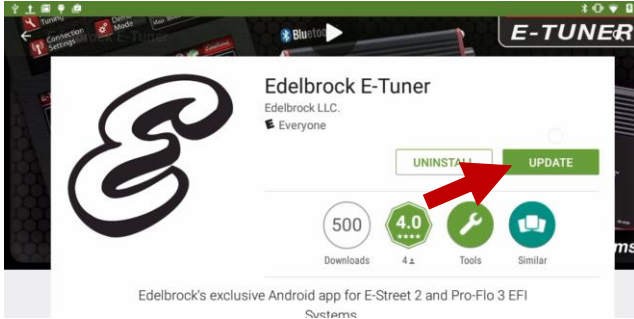
3) Select: My Apps



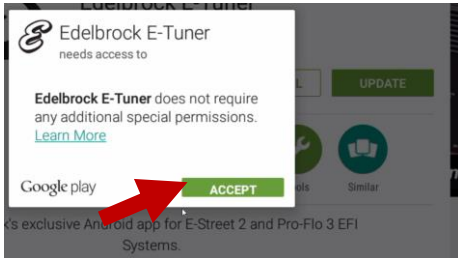
4) Scroll down & Select the Edelbrock E-Tuner app. The word "update" should be shown to the right, if an update is available.



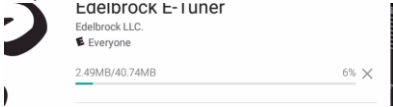
- 5) This will open the E-Tuner app listing page. You should see an Update Button is available. Select the **Update** button.



- 6) For most devices, you will be asked to accept the Installation from Google Play. Select: **ACCEPT**



- 7) Google Play will now start downloading the app. This can take several minutes, depending on your WIFI/Data connection. This is a fairly large app file, so 2 - 3 minutes can be expected.



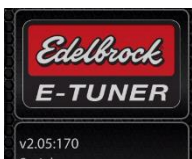
- 8) Once the download reaches 100%, your device will automatically install the app. This can take a few seconds.



- 9) When the app is finished installing, you can Open the E-Tuner app.



- 10) Verify the app version from the E-Tuner Main Menu. The most recent app version will be listed on the Google Play Store & on the Edelbrock EFI Websites. In this example, we will be updating to v2.05:170.



Your E-Tuner app is now updated to the latest version. Please check the Edelbrock EFI Websites if there are any new maps or firmware updates. You can refer to the E-Tuner App – Firmware Update & E-Tuner App – Calibration Map Update documents for full instructions.
